**Prerequisites: Participants must**

Be a minimum of 17 years of age on the date of final assessment  
Complete an 800 metre swim in 14 minutes or less in a swimming pool no less than 25 m  
(To be signed off by a pool lifeguard/pool representative.  
This is the responsibility of the individual member to complete prior to attending the examination date)

**Participants must be proficient in the following SLSA awards:**

Bronze Medallion/Certificate II in Public Safety (Aquatic Rescue)  
Advanced Resuscitation Certificate  
Apply (senior) First Aid

Upon successful completion of this course participants will receive the SLSA Gold Medallion (Advanced Lifesaving) Certificate, please note this is a SLSA recognized award. Members will be allocated the PUASAR017A unit of competency upon completion of the Gold Medallion Mission

**Enrolment Process:**

Interested members are to book through their Chief Training Officers/Secretary. Clubs are to then complete the online registration form located on the SLSCC secure members area on the SLSCC website (www.slscc.com.au )  
Upon confirmation of course enrolment, participants will receive an email with Participant Joining Instructions outlining any gear and equipment required and any other instructions.
